Title: Advisory to seek medical attention for persons in contact with COVID-19 cases

According to the COVID-19 disease examination report in search for persons who came into contact with confirmed COVID-19 cases found in Prachuap Khiri Khan Province. It has been reported that the COVID-19 patients were two passengers on a van or bus without clear information on how many passengers were on board and no means of contact to alert them to seek medical attention. However, there are some information about the bus/van.

In order to ensure the safety of the public and reduce the potential risk that may occur to the people and furthermore, to be aware, protect and control the spread of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 in Prachuap Khiri Khan Province, in accordance to section 22, 34 and 45 of the Communicable Diseases Act, B.E. 2558 (2015), it is to advised to do as follows:

Passengers who travelled on the same bus/van as the COVID-19 patients are advised to seek medical attention by seeing the doctor at a nearby hospital. Details of the vehicles are as follows;

1. Van: registered plate number 156842 Bangkok, 978-22 JKP, Platform Number 1, departed from Southern Bus Terminal (Sai Tai Mai) on 16 March 2020. Time of departure: 2:45 P.M.
2. Minibus: registered plate number 16-2418 Bangkok, 985-20 Bangkok-Pranburi Jakkrapan Tour, Platform Number 7, departed from Mo Chit Station on 12 March 2020. Time of departure: 2 P.M.
