Title: Temporary Suspend the Crossing of people, vehicle and objects at Singha Khon Special Border Checkpoint and others channels along the border of Prachuap Khiri Khan Province

According to the announcement of Ministry of Public Health dated 26 February 2020, title: detailing the name of the virus and symptoms of the virus (3rd edition), has identified coronavirus 2019 or Covid-19 as a dangerous virus. Hence, the number of coronavirus infected patients is continue to rising, as a result, Prachuap Khiri Khan Province has announced the order of the committee of the communicable disease (1st issue dated 19 March 2020): for closing establishments and enterprises in order to avoid the gathering of people which will pose a high risk of spreading the disease.

As in this emergency situation, in order to, suppress and control the spread of coronavirus 2019 or Covid-19 and for the safety of people of the two countries at Singha Khon Special Border Checkpoint. The Director of Thailand-Myanmar Border Command Center, Prachuap Khiri Khan Province, by virtue of cabinet resolution dated 26 January 2016, title: criterion and guideline in considering for opening – closing any border checkpoint, order as follow:

1. Suspend the use of Singha Khon Special Border Checkpoint at Moo 6, Klongwan Sub-District, Muang District, Prachuap Khiri Khan Province.
2. People, vehicles and any objects are suspended from crossing in any border areas along Prachuap Khiri Khan Province

Effective from 21 march 2563 (Time: 6.30 PM.) until 3 April 2020 (Time: 6.30 PM.)
