



Order of the Committee of Communicable Disease, Prachuap Khiri Khan Province

No. 4/2020

Title: Emergency Preventive Measure regarding Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Pandemic

According to the announcement of emergency decree in all areas of the Kingdom of Thailand, from 26 March B.E. 2563 (2020) to 30 April B.E. 2563 (2020)

In order to solve the problem in the emergency situation of infection of Coronavirus Disease 2019 or COVID-19 in Prachuap Khiri Khan effectively based on the section 22, 34 and 45 of communicable disease act, B.E. 2558 (2015) comprising of item 7(1) and 30 (the 2nd space) of the regulation in the section 9 of royal act in the emergency situation B.E. 2558 (2015) 1st issue. Provincial governor of Prachuap Khiri Khan as disease control officers by approving of the committee of the communicable disease, Prachuap Khiri Khan ordered to establish the checkups of control of Coronavirus Disease 2019 or COVID-19 infection as follows:

1. Establish the checkups of control of Coronavirus Disease 2019 infection for screening people that travel from other districts in Prachuap Khiri Khan as well as monitoring the travelers' symptoms and behaviors that risk of infection for 3 checkups as:

1.1 The checkup of control of Coronavirus Disease 2019 infection is in front of Hua Hin district office: the way of going down to the south of Thailand (TL 4 KM 34 T. Taptai, Hua Hin District, Prachuap Khiri Khan)

1.2 The checkup of control of Coronavirus Disease 2019 infection is in front of center of public service at Bor Fai, Hua Hin Police Station: the way of going down to the south of Thailand (TL 4 KM 211 + 174 T. Taptai, Hua Hin District, Prachuap Khiri Khan)

1.3 The checkup of control of Coronavirus Disease 2019 infection is in front of center of public service at Chaiyarat, Bang Saphan Noi Police Station: the way of going up to Bangkok (TL 4 KM 421 + 300 T. Chaiyarat, Bang Saphan Noi District, Prachuap Khiri Khan)

2. Asking the control of Coronavirus Disease 2019 infection officers to work for 24 hours divided into 3 shifts:

2.1 1st shift starting from 8.00 AM. – 4.00 PM.

2.2 2nd shift starting from 4.00 PM. – 12.00 AM.

2.3 3rd shift starting from 12.00 AM. – 8.00 AM.

3. Asking the control of Coronavirus Disease 2019 infection officers of each shift to Cooperate with the administration, police, transport staff and public health officers:

3.1 The police of Prachuap Khiri Khan provincial police station and local police station are on duty at the checkup: not less than 12 police/shift/point.

3.2 The administrative officers and members of Voluntary Guard Division from the local area work the checkup: not less than 7 guards/shift/point.

3.3 Prachuap Khiri Khan provincial health officer in the local area work at the checkup: 1 officer/shift/ point.

3.4 Transport officers of Prachuap Khiri Khan provincial transport office and the local area work at the checkup: not less than 2 officers/ shift/point.

3.5 Asking a sheriff that have an authority to assign other government officers, executives of local government, sub district headmen, village headmen, assistants of village headman, officers of Subdivision of Safety and Security, village security guards, members of Volunteer Defense Corps, Civil Defense Volunteers, Village Health Volunteers in order to work at the checkup.

3.6 Asking the superintendent of the local area to be in charge of the head of the team and report overall operation after finish working of each shift to the commandant of Prachuap Khiri Khan provincial police station and Prachuap Khiri Khan provincial governor consequently. So that, if there are any emergency situations, must report to the local sheriff and the commandant of local police station immediately.

4. Asking administrative agencies, local administrative organization and public Enterprises to support any work of the checkup as the local sheriff assigned.

5. Asking the local sheriff to supervise and solve any problems during working at the checkup.

This Order shall take effect on March 26, 2020 onwards.
