of the Committee of Communicable Disease of Prachuap Khiri Khan Province

Title: Regulations for travelers from Disease Infected Zones  
and Ongoing Local Transmission Areas

---

In reference to the Notification of the Ministry of Public Health Re: Designation and Main Symptoms of Dangerous Communicable Diseases (Issue 3) dated on February 26, 2020, which declared Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) a dangerous communicable disease as set forth in the Communicable Diseases Act B.E. 2558 (2015), and the Notification of the Ministry of Public Health Re: Territories Outside the Kingdom of Thailand Defined as Disease Infected Zones of the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak dated on March 2, 2020.

For the public interest and the prevention and reduction of potential risks to the general public, and precautions to control the spread of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 in Prachuap Khiri Khan Province in accordance with section 22, 34 and 45 of the Communicable Diseases Act, B.E. 2558 (2015), hereby announce as follows:

1. All travelers coming from 'high-risk' countries or 'Disease Infected Zones' which includes 4 countries namely China (including Hong Kong and Macau), South Korea, Italy, and Spain whom do not present any symptoms of the disease, must submit the filled documents (T.8 Form) to communicable disease control officers, or fill the form via AOT Airport of Thailand mobile phone application. In addition, they shall be self-quarantined at their place of residence (Home Quarantine) for a period of 14 days from the date of arrival from those Disease Infected Zones and allow communicable disease control officers to monitor symptoms every day.

2. All travelers coming back from Ongoing Local Transmission Areas with numerous and staggering cases of COVID-19 infections such as France, Spain, USA, Switzerland, Norway, Japan, Denmark, the Netherlands, Sweden, Great Britain, and Germany (as defined by the Department of Disease Control) whom do not present any symptoms of the disease, must submit the filled documents (T.8 Form) to communicable disease control officers, or fill the form via AOT Airport of Thailand mobile phone application. In addition, they shall be self-quarantined at their place of residence (Home Quarantine) for a period of 14 days from the date of arrival from those Disease Infected Zones and truthfully report symptoms to communicable disease control officers every day.
