Title: Bringing foreign aliens to report (except migrant workers from Cambodia, Laos, and Myanmar)

With reference to the fact that the Governor of Prachuap Khiri Khan, in his capacity as the Supervisor for Public Administration in the Emergency Situation of Prachuap Khiri Khan, has ordered the temporary closure of mass gathering venues and venues at risk of the dangerous communicable disease, including the closing of hotels which have hotel licenses of all types according to the Hotel Act B.E. 2547 (2004) and other business establishments offering similar services until 30 April 2020, as well as the measures for foreign nationals (except migrant workers from Cambodia, Laos, and Myanmar) entering the Prachuap Khiri Khan area to present themselves for disease checking and screening.

Apparently, the order to close all types of hotels which have hotel licenses according to the Hotel Act B.E. 2547 (2004) and other business establishments offering similar services, may cause difficulties for foreigners leaving the closed hotels and travelling back to their countries, therefore, these foreigners are still allowed to stay in the area, stay in condos, rental homes and dormitories paying monthly rental fees. The staying can cause meetings and gatherings of these foreigners and may cause the spread of the Corona virus 2019.

In order to prevent the spread of the Corona virus 2019 in Prachuap Khiri Khan Province, by the virtue according to section 22 of Communicable Disease Act 2558 B.E. and 7(1) of Regulation of section 9 of Emergency Decree 2548 B.E. (No. 1) dated on 25 March 2020 and Article 38 of the Immigration Act 2522 B.E. are imposed.

Therefore, the owners, landlords, householders and administrators of the condominiums, rental homes, rental rooms and dormitories which have foreigners residing (except migrant workers from Cambodia, Laos, and Myanmar) who have not yet reported to the district or

notify the immigration office or screening by the disease control officers must be responsible for informing or taking such foreigners to the district hospital or to the designated local sheriff office or informing the district officers or the disease control officers to continue monitoring and screening the disease according to the disease control measures.
