



Prachuap Khiri Khan Province Order

No. 4676/2563

Topic: Surveillance, Prevention, and Closing risky locations that may cause spreading of dangerous communicable disease

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According to the Prime Minister's announcement of the State of Emergency in all areas throughout the kingdom of Thailand from 26 March 2020 and later extended the enforcement of the Emergency Announcement until 31 May 2020.

In order to curb the spread of the communicable disease, Covid-19 and prevent the disease from spreading again in areas that have previously been controlled. The Prime Minister, therefore, has the authority under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree, B.E. 2548 and Section 11 of the Administrative Affairs Act, B.E. 2534, issued the Regulations of section 9 of Emergency Decree B.E. 2548 (No. 5) dated on 1 May 2020 stated that the provincial governors shall issue an order to close the premises which are at risk of spreading the disease.

Therefore, in order to proceed successfully in accordance with the Regulation (No. 5) of section 9 of Emergency Decree B.E. 2548. And to be able to successfully prevent and stop the outbreak of the Covid-19 disease by the virtue of section 34(1), 35(1) of Communicable Disease Act, B.E. 2558, article (5) and article 7(1) of Regulation of section 9 of Emergency Decree B.E. 2548 (No. 1) dated on 25 March 2020, article 2(6) of section 9 of Emergency Decree B.E. 2548, Prachuap Khiri Khan Province governor with approval of Prachuap Khiri Khan Province Communicable Disease Committee meeting 12/2563 on May 2, 2020 has placed an order as detailed below:

1. Temporary closure of the premises which are at risk of spreading the Covid-19 disease until May 31 2020 or until the Prime Minister announced otherwise, as follows:

1.1 Playhouses, theaters, cinemas

1.2 Entertainment places, pubs, bars, entertainment venues, similar entertainment service facilities

/1.3 Playgrounds...

1.3 Playgrounds, public swimming pools, water parks, amusement parks, zoos

1.4 Skating or rollerblading places or other similar activities

1.5 Snookers, billiards, bowling venues or games arcades

1.6 Games and internet shops

1.7 Cockfighting facilities, Fish fighting facilities

1.8 Sports venues, fitness centers, beauty clinics

1.9 Public libraries, museums, exhibition centers, convention centers, exhibition halls

1.10 Nurseries and nursing homes

1.11 Boxing stadiums, martial arts schools (gyms)

1.12 Tattoo and body piercing services

1.13 Social Dance Academy or Social Dance training

1.14 Bathing, Sauna and herbal steaming establishments

1.15 Health establishments, Thai Massage, foot Massage establishments, except in Government Agencies.

1.16 Massage parlor establishments

Therefore, the government agencies / Local Administrative Organizations which have legal authority related to the places of responsibilities shall supervise and monitor the above operations.

2. Set up checkpoints for the Covid-19 epidemic control to monitor, screen and observe symptoms and risky behaviors of people who travel to Prachuap Khiri Khan Province, in the main routes as follows:

2.1 The area in front of Hua Hin District Office, southbound, National highway 37, KM. 34, Thap Tai Sub-district, Hua Hin District, Prachuap Khiri Khan Province

2.2 The area in front of Bo Fai Public Service Center, Hua Hin Police Station, southbound, National highway 4, KM 211 + 174, Bo Fai Sub-district, Hua Hin District, Prachuap Khiri Khan Province

2.3 The area in front of the Chai Rat Public Service Center, Bang Saphan Noi Police Station, northbound, National highway 4, KM 421 + 300, Chai Rat Sub-district, Bang Saphan Noi District, Prachuap Khiri Khan Province

2.4 The area in front of Nong Prik Intersection, Village No. 5, Sai Thong Sub-district, Bang Saphan Noi District, Prachuap Khiri Khan Province

In this regard, there shall be the integration of relevant departments, consists of Administrative Authorities, Police Officers, Transport Officers, Public Health Officers to join the operation. There shall be local sheriffs to oversee, direct, order, solve the problems and have the authority to assign local administrators and other civil servants, the village headmen, assistant village headmen, Village security teams, Members of the Territorial Defense Volunteer Division, the Civil Defense volunteers, Public health volunteers to join the operation and have Deputy District Chiefs assigned as The head of the operation that is divided into 3 shifts as follows:

1. 1st shift from 08:00 - 16:00 hrs.
2. 2nd shift from 16.00 - 24.00 hrs.
3. 3rd shift from 00:00 - 08:00 hrs.

3. Every district is to establish checkpoints, screening points in the sub-districts, communities and villages that are considered risky points for the epidemic in order to screen the entry and exit of people who are at risk. In case there is a suspicion of person being infected with Covid-19, the person should be retained for observation or to be examined.

If a person comes from outside of the province where there is spreading of coronary virus 2019 and the person is residing in the area. Have the communicable disease control officers who are responsible for the area issue a 14-day detention order to monitor the symptoms (Home Quarantine)

4. The disease control officers shall monitor the assemblies, activities or gatherings at any crowded places or any acts that may instigate the disturbance. If the offense is found, the person shall be arrested and strictly prosecuted.

If any persons violate or fail to comply with these regulations according to section 51 of the Communicable Decease Act, B.E. 2558, the penalty is a fine not exceeding twenty thousand baht and according to section 52 of the Communicable Decease Act, B.E. 2558, the penalties are imprisonment not exceeding 1 year or fine not exceeding one hundred thousand baht, or both, and punishable under Section 18 of the Emergency Decree B.E. 2548 , imprisonment not exceeding two years or a fine not exceeding forty thousand baht or both.

Effective from May 3, 2020 until otherwise ordered.
