



Prachuap Khiri Khan Province Order

No. 4677/2563

Topic: The relief of enforcement of some measures concerning the prevention of the Covid-19 Epidemic.

According to the Prime Minister's announcement of the State of Emergency in all areas throughout the kingdom of Thailand as from 26 March 2020 and later extended the enforcement of the Emergency Announcement until 31 May 2020,

It is reasonable to relieve the enforcement of some measures concerning the prevention of the COVID-19 epidemic by complying with the procedures of the risk control; people, places and types of related activities in order to reduce the impact on the economy, society and security, according to the criteria of World Health Organization and the evaluation of situations by Health Department, by listening to opinions from the Economic Department, entrepreneurs and consumers, but still comply with the disease prevention measures and government recommendations. By the virtue according to section 35 (1) of Communicable Disease Act 2558 B.E and 7(1) of regulation of section 9 of Emergency Decree 2548 B.E. (No.3.) dated on 25 March 2020 and section 9 of Emergency Decree 2548 B.E. (No.6) dated 1 May 2020. The governor of Prachuap Khiri Khan Province (with approval of Prachuap Khiri Khan Province communicable disease committee meeting 12/2563 on 2 May 2020) order that

1. The measures have been relieved by allowing some operations or activities to voluntarily reopen from May 3, onward as follows:

(1) Economic and daily life activities

A. Sales of food or beverages in hotels, airports, train stations, bus stations, hospitals, restaurants or café, convenience stores, street vendors, hawkers, and booths, excluding pubs and bars, which can be operated by selling take away only. If the operation will be performed in that certain place, it can be done by organizing access to the service in accordance with the disease prevention measures and government recommendations.

For restaurants that sell alcohol beverages, can be opened, however, drinking alcohol beverages in the restaurant is prohibited.

/B. Department...

B. Department Stores, Shopping Centers, Community Malls can be opened only at supermarkets, pharmacies, miscellaneous items that are essential for living and retail shops. Telecommunications businesses, banks, government agencies or state enterprises only can be opened, as for the restaurants, can be operated by selling take away only.

C. Small retail stores / wholesale stores, community retail stores / wholesale stores, markets, floating markets and flea markets to be opened by controlling entrances and exits, arranging for body temperature testing for both consumers and sellers. Provide distance spaces while consumers choosing products and making payments.

D. Beauty salons, hairdressing or haircut for men or women, can only be opened for washing, cutting, styling and customers waiting in the shop is prohibited.

(2) Economic and daily life activities

A. Hospitals, clinics, dental facilities or all types of nursing homes which are legally established.

B. Golf courses or golf training facilities can be opened, but gathering of spectators or competing is prohibited. In the case of clubs, clubhouses or restaurants in the areas mentioned must follow the instruction of (1)A.

C. Stadiums, specifically, outdoor sports which the players must play by following social distancing and not close up as the international rules such as tennis, horse riding, shooting and archery. Gathering of spectators or competing is prohibited. In the case of clubs, clubhouses or restaurants in the areas mentioned must follow the instruction of (1)A.

D. Public parks, courtyards, public activities areas and sports stadiums can be opened only in the open space areas for walking, running, riding or biking, or other personal exercising methods. Gathering of spectators, competing, performing plays and shows are prohibited.

E. Animal care facilities, animal spas, baths, grooming or pet nursing homes.

2. If the orders of Prachuap Khiri Khan Province Communicable Disease Committee and any orders of Prachuap Khiri Khan Province are not comply or inconsistent with this order, the execution must follow this order and the announcement of Prachuap Khiri Khan Province, title: Regulation according to section 9 of Emergency Decree 2548 B.E. dated May 2, 2020.

Effective as from May 3, 2020 until otherwise ordered.
