



Prachuap Khiri Khan Provincial Order

No. 3929/ 2021

Topic: Measures to prevent and control the spread of Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)
and the operating of government agencies

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According to Prachuap Khiri Khan Province, Order 3836 / 2021 dated April 13, 2021 shut down the vulnerable facility, which appears to be the site of the coronavirus outbreak and distribution of Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19); defining the roles of communicable disease control officers, especially local officials ; conditions and measures for the operation and activities of the people ; wearing a face mask or cloth mask before going out; including asking infected persons to provide information to the Communicable Disease Control Authority in the investigation of the disease to prevent and control the spread of coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) in Prachuap Khiri Khan Province, in order to return to normal as soon as possible.

Prachuap Khiri Khan Province has ordered the lifting and tightening of practices and enforcement measures, but it still appears that the increase in people infected with coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) has continued to increase significantly. There has been an increase in inter-family epidemics. If the situation continues to be left in such a way, it may affect the potential of the public health service system and may affect the public service of government agencies. If it appears that government officials in the agency are infected with coronavirus 2019 (COVID - 19). On April 16, 2021, the Prime Minister specified the section 9 of the Public Administration Decree on the Emergency Situation in 2005 (No.20) leveled the situation area of Prachuap Khiri Khan Province to the highest controlled area. According to the changing circumstances and in accordance with the guidelines of the regulations issued in accordance with the section 9 of the Decree on Public Administration on the Emergency Situation in 2005 (No.20) therefore relies on the authority under Section 22 and 34 of the Communicable Diseases Act B.E. 2558 (2015) Clause 2 and 7(1) of the Requirements issued in accordance with Section 9 of the Public Administration Decree on the Emergency Situation in 2005 (No. 1) dated March 25, 2020, clauses 1, 3, 5, and 6 of the terms issued in accordance with Section 9 of the Public Administration Decree on the Emergency Situation in 2005 (No. 20) dated April 16, 2021, and Section 57 of the Public Administration Act B.E. 2534 (1991), the Governor of Prachuap Khiri Khan Province, with the approval of the Communicable Diseases Committee, Prachuap Khiri Khan Province,

according to the resolution of the Meeting No.15/2021 dated April 19, 2021 to prevent and control of spreading Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) in Prachuap Khiri Khan Province as follows:

1. Repeal clauses 4.1 and 4.2 of Prachuap Khiri Khan Provincial Order No. 3836/ 2021 dated April 13, 2021 and use the following instead:

4.1 Request to postpone or refrain from organizing banquets, carnivals or events that include people in public or private spaces, unless it is a traditional ceremony and has no more than 50 participants. This must be authorized by the District Disease Control Operations Center (TSD) and follow the rules and conditions prescribed by Prachuap Khiri Khan Provincial Health Office.

4.2 Activities are prohibited from being organized by a group of 50 or more individuals, except those operated by government agencies. Organizing activities in areas defined as quarantine facilities /field hospitals"

2. Measures to prevent and control the spread of the epidemic in the area

2.1 To govern Prachuap Khiri Khan Province and all district administrations. Setup a fast-moving operational team to monitor, enforce, comply the law according to Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005), Prachuap Khiri Khan Provincial Orders, and the measures of local communicable disease by the Centre for the Administration of the COVID-19. If it is found any offenders, they must be arrested and prosecuted according to the law. And report to the Prachuap Khiri Khan office.

2.2. To the Administrative Officer, Subdistrict Headman, Village Headman, President of the Local Government Organization and Permanent Secretary of the Local Government Organization Area as a Communicable disease control officer, jointly set up a community/village checkpoint. To screen, measure body temperature all individuals entering the village/community. If the results appear to have a high fever ranging from 37.5 degrees Celsius, inform the local health authorities to screen, investigate the disease and take it to the examination. However, if the results show that there is no fever, check where the person has traveled from, whether it's risky or not.

2.3. To those persons who have arrived from the provinces of the highest controlled areas. Report to the Communicable Diseases Control Officer to screen, measure body temperature and inquire about their symptoms.

2.4 For those persons that have traveled from the highest controlled provinces, Subdistrict Headman, the village headman, President of the Local Government Organization and Permanent Secretary of the Local Government Organization Area as a Communicable disease control officer as a communicable disease control officer. In accordance with Section 34 of the Communicable Diseases Act B.E. 2558 (2015) instructs such persons to separate, quarantine or observe at residential or housing areas for at least 14 days. Ask for symptoms of such persons, including those closest to them who have lived in the same house for at least 14 days, and if abnormalities are detected, notify local health officials immediately.

3. Off-site operations, switching work days or any other appropriate method

3.1 The head of government agency/executive assigns personnel to work from home and requires the use of internet and line applications and other applications in order to communicate and perform all kinds of tasks to the fullest capacity. The personnel enable to use communication tools to coordinate at any time and have all agencies to switch them to work at the workplace by taking into account on serving people as a priority. If it is a public service that can be arranged in advance, assign an officer to make an appointment in order to reduce number and congestion of visitors on a day-to-day basis.

3.2 Let the head of the government agency/executive determine the appropriate clear method. In order to assign personnel to work at the residence, as well as ask them to report performance during the non-performing period at the workplace by taking into account the assigned operational goals and the benefits of the government according to the guidelines of Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC) about working outside of the government office.

3.3 All government agencies/agencies shall refrain from attending meetings, seminars and field trips or any activities which gather many participants. If the event is necessary to be held for the benefit of the government, it can be held according to this order guideline. Nevertheless, it should be considered on organizing the event through online as a priority.

3.4 In the workplace and other places, all government officials and personnel are strictly compliant with the Ministry of Public Health's disease prevention measures, such as temperature monitoring, wearing face masks or cloth masks at all times, washing your hands with soap or alcohol gel, avoiding touching surface's and keep physical distancing. All civil servants and personnel must behave as a model and avoid participating in activities that include large numbers of people or traveling to risky areas. In case of people contacting the government, have them to strictly comply with the ministry of health's disease prevention measures.

4 Abstaining or delaying to travel outside Prachuap Khiri Khan Province

4.1 The head of the provincial government office and the sheriff shall be in the government office in Prachuap Khiri Khan Province to monitor the situation of the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) to have the tool to communicate and be able to communicate at any time.

4.2 The head of the provincial government office and the sheriff shall prepare equipment and personnel to support the operation if Prachuap Khiri Khan province needs to mobilize officers to solve problems or help the people.

4.3 To all government officials and personnel refrain from or delay to travel outside Prachuap Khiri Khan Province to support the Prachuap Khiri Khan governor' operation and reduce the risk of infection as well as the spread of coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19).

from the risky provinces. Except if there are emergencies or other necessities which are only permitted as a letter from the supervisor.

Violating or failing to comply the order the communicable disease control officer, which is an offense under the Communicable Disease Act B.E.2558 with violation of non-compliance with this order under section 51 of the Communicable Disease Act B.E 2558 shall be liable to a fine not exceeding twenty thousand baht. Offenses under section 52 of the Communicable Disease Act B.E 2558 shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year, a fine not exceeding on hundred thousand baht, or both. It may be wrong and was punished under Section 18 of the Royal Civil Service Regulations in Emergency Situation B.E. 2558.

In addition, since it is a cause of urgency for the protection of the welfare of the people and public interest. If left, it will cause a serious damage to the public. Therefore, it may not be given to the parties exercise the right to object according to Section 30, paragraph 2 (1) of the Administrative Procedure Act B.E. 2539
