



Prachuap Khiri Khan Provincial Order

No. 3836 / 2564

Topic : Preventive Measure and the closure of risky places due to control
Coronavirus Disease 2019 (Covid -19) pandemic

According to the order of Prachuap Khiri Khan Governor No. 3835/2564 dated April,10 2021 Closure of all public places in accordance with Service Places Act BE. 2509, all establishments; pubs, bar, karaoke in Prachuap Khiri Khan for 14 days, from April,10-23 2021. The governor has also assigned the Center for Communicable Disease Control to check time, places, activities which might be at risk of spreading of the disease, and strictly organize and follow instructions according to the order.

It has been found that the coronavirus-19 continues to spread throughout Prachuap Khiri Khan, from one to another without showing any symptom. Therefore, there is a need to enforce strict and urgent measures for the environment. To prevent and suppress the spread of this disease in locations at risk of transmission of disease, inhibit the spread of disease from spreading more widely.

Therefore, Prachuap Khiri Khan Province relies on the authority under Section 34 and 35 (1) of the Communicable Disease Act B.E. 2558 Clause 2 and Clause 7 (1) of the provisions issued under Section 9 of the Royal Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations, B.E. 2558 (No.1) dated March 25, 2020 clause 7 of the requirements issued under section 9 of the Royal Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situation, B.E 2558 (No.18) dated January,29 B.E 2554 Clause 3 of the provisions issued under Section 9 of the Royal Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situation B.E. 2558 (No. 19) dated April,10 2021 and Section 57 of the State Administration Regulations Act B.E.2534. Provincial Governor of Prachuap Khiri Khan with the approval of the Prachuap Khiri Khan Provincial Communicable Disease Committee according to the resolution of the 12th /2021 meeting dated 13 April 2021, has ordered the closure of places of risk and put urgent measures to prevent and control the spreading of Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) in Prachuap Khiri Khan Province as follows

1. Any order of the Prachuap Khiri Khan Communicable Disease Committee is contrary to or inconsistent with this order to replace this issue of the Prachuap Khiri Khan Communicable Disease Committee.

/2. To close...

2. **To close** the places as follows:

- 2.1 A place for animal fighting or gambling, and any other similar venue.
- 2.2 Social establishments, similar establishments to, pubs, bars.
- 2.3 Water parks, amusement parks and swimming pools.
- 2.4 Children's playgrounds, children's play equipment and amusement equipment which are windmills, wind houses, ball houses, or other similar rides located in water markets, flea markets, department stores, shopping malls and community malls in Prachuap Khiri Khan Province.
- 2.5 Snooker and Billiard clubs / gaming halls
- 2.6 Arcade games, arcade and internet cafes
- 2.7 Martial Arts School
- 2.8 Establishments like massage parlors
- 2.9 Cinema or theater
- 2.10 Tutoring institutes
- 2.11 Health establishments that feature steam baths, facials, except Thai massage, foot massage or medical treatment in a public medical facility.
- 2.12 Boxing training ground, gym or boxing camp.
- 2.13 Fitness venues or arrange the issuance and exercise inside a closed system building and any other place of the same nature.

3. To have the administrative officer of the village headman, President of the Local Government Organization and Permanent Secretary of the Local Government Organization Area as a Communicable disease control officer:

3.1 Establish a network and track outsider's entry and exit, by having to screen and measure the body temperature of all persons traveling into the village / community including checking, searching, screening, measuring body temperature, people in the village /community that go to service establishments or establishments that are similar to service establishments, pubs, karaoke, bars, which are vulnerable areas as required by it appears from news and information published from Prachuap Khiri Khan Provincial Public Health Office or people in the area travel back from those areas.

3.2 If the test results show a high fever from 37.5 degrees Celsius, notify the district health officer of the area and take the ones to enter the screening, investigate the disease and take it for a test for Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19). If the test result show that there is no fever, check where the person has traveled from, the place 's risky or not.

3.3 If it is found that the person is travelling from a risky place/ risk area in the province and outside the province that is the most controlled area of the Coronavirus outbreak 2019 (COVID-19), use the authority under Section 34 of the Communicable Diseases Act B.E. 2558 to order such persons to isolate, quarantine, to observe at residential area or dwelling place for not less than 14 days.

/3.4 If you are...

3.4 If you are a relative or close to a patient infected with Covid-19 or a person pending results, the disease examination shall be used authorized under Section 34 of the Communicable Disease Act B.E.2558, be instructed or commanded to separate quarantine, quarantine or observation at a residence or dwelling place for not less than 14 days.

4. Conditions and measures for operation and organizing activities to unite people

4.1 It is forbidden to organize a carnival, or activities that include people in public areas, or personal space unless a traditional event such as wedding, ordination, funeral which is authorized by The District Disease Control Operation Center and has complied with the criteria and conditions required by the to Office of Public Health Prachuap Khiri Khan Province. And requiring the organizers to have a carnival is obliged to arrange for the participants follow the D-M-H-T-T principle of keeping at least 1-meter social distance. Wear a mask or cloth mask. Regularly wash your hands with soap or alcohol gel and measure your body temperature before entering or attending activities, and use application “Thai Chana”

4.2 It is forbidden to hold meetings, seminars and banquets, unless it is a meeting, seminar and banquet held by a government agency, or it is a banquet with no more than 50 people. If there are 50 or more, but not more than 100 people, the organizer must obtain permission from the District Disease Control Operation Center. However, whether the organizer is government agency or not, the D-M-H-T-T principle is being used; that is keeping at least 1 meter social distance. Wear a mask or cloth mask. Regularly wash your hands with soap or alcohol gel and measure your body temperature before entering or attending activities, and use application “Thai Chana”

4.3 Restaurants, food establishments that provide dining tables, should have a distance of at least 1 meter between tables. If it is a long table, create a partition and limit the number of people sitting inside the store. In accordance with the D- M-H-T-T principle; keeping at least 1-meter social distance, wear a mask or cloth mask. Regularly wash your hands with soap or alcohol gel and measure your body temperature before entering shop selling food or beverages, and use application “Thai Chana”. Including prohibiting the consumption of alcohol or alcoholic beverages within the shop.

4.4 Tourist attractions that are in overseeing the supervision of government agencies especially the various parks in the area which are open to the public and tourists, ensuring strict adherence to public health measures. Strictly used the D-M-H-T-T practice, a minimum of 1-meter social distance, wearing a mask or cloth mask, regularly wash your hands with soap or alcohol gel and measure your body temperature before entering the place, and use application “Thai Chana”

5. Have everyone wear a surgical mask or cloth mask before leaving the home or dwelling place every time. Violation is an offense of contravention. To order officials under the Criminal Code shall be liable to a fine not exceeding twenty thousand baht. In accordance with the Communicable Diseases Act B.E.2558 or shall be liable to the punishment as prescribed by the Criminal Code.

6. Infectious persons who intentionally conceal their travel information or have reported false information to the official Communication disease control makes it an obstacle to disease investigation and control. As a result, germs can spread potentially violating or failing to comply with the law. To order the communicable disease control officer, which is an offense under the Communicable Disease Act B.E.2558

with violation of non-compliance with this order under section 51 of the Communicable Disease Act B.E 2558 shall be liable to a fine not exceeding twenty thousand baht. Offenses under section 52 of the Communicable Disease Act B.E 2558 shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year, a fine not exceeding on hundred thousand baht, or both. It may be wrong and was punished under Section 18 of the Royal Civil Service Regulations in Emergency Situation B.E. 2558.

In addition, since it is a cause of urgency for the protection of the welfare of the people and public interest. If left, it will cause a serious damage to the public. Therefore, it may not be given to the parties exercise the right to object according to Section 30, paragraph 2 (1) of the Administrative Procedure Act B.E. 2539

Effective as from April13, 2021 until otherwise ordered
